





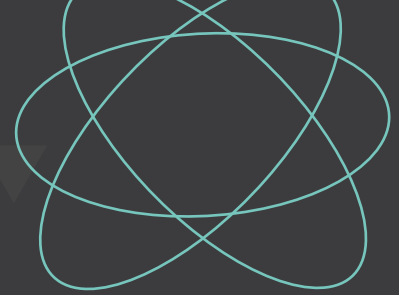
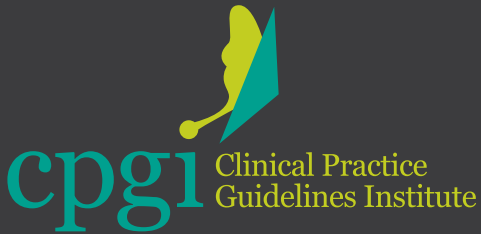
Save the date.
