7 Ways to WIN!!!!

1. **ATTEND:** Attend a CAG National Basic Science and CanMEDS Lecture via webinar and email Joanne@cag-acg.org before 1:15 PM ET with the Participation Points **Password of the Day** that will be communicated verbally during the webinar. **5 points** will be awarded per webinar.
2. **INTERACT:** During a webinar lecture, identify yourself and ask the presenter one or more questions via text, speaker phone, or PollEverywhere and you will earn a total of **5 points** for your interaction during that webinar.
3. **VOLUNTEER:** Contact joanne@cag-acg.org now (or at least 24 hours before the start of the webinar) and volunteer to introduce the presenter and thank them upon the conclusion of the presentation. You will be provided with a short bio prior to the lecture. **The first person to volunteer will be granted this opportunity. 10 points** will be awarded per webinar to this volunteer.
4. **PRE-TEST:** 3 Pre-Test questions will be distributed with the lecture Reminder email that will be sent out a few days prior to the webinar. If you email joanne@cag-acg.org with your answers to the 3 Pre-test Multiple Choice Questions, **prior to the webinar**, you will be awarded **10 points**. *(The correct answers will be individually emailed to you two weeks after the webinar when the Evaluation link and Post-test is closed).*
5. **SHARE:** At the start of one of the 7 scheduled webinars (12h00 ET), take 1-2 minutes to share with your colleagues across Canada, a topic-related patient case. Please include a question related to that case for the speaker to address. It would be preferred to have advance notice that you will be sharing a patient case so that we may ensure there will be time allotted to address the case. **The first person to contact joanne@cag-acg.org who volunteers to share a patient case will be granted this opportunity to earn 20 points.** (One case per webinar).
6. **EVALUATE:** Complete the 3 Post-test questions and 7 evaluation questions on survey monkey. The link will be mailed out following the webinar and open for two weeks to earn **25 points**. If you missed the live lecture and view the course on the CAG ePortal under “Residents’ Corner” you may earn 25 points if you email Joanne your completed evaluation form from the ePortal.
7. **LEARN MORE:** Following the lecture (live or ePortal) develop a Personal Learning Project (PLP) to carry forward for MOC Section Two Self-Learning credits. Submit a copy of the completed PLP form (found on the [CAG Tools Library](#)) to joanne@cag-acg.org to earn **35 points**.
