The Division of Gastroenterology at McMaster University is internationally recognized for clinical care, research and education.</p> <p>The successful candidate will be a full-time member of the Division of Gastroenterology and is expected to contribute to the academic mission of the Faculty and Division. Academic responsibilities will include clinical supervision of trainees, and a significant educational role in the undergraduate and post-graduate medical programs. Clinical</p>

responsibilities will include advanced endoscopy, and thus training and experience in ERCP and endoscopic mucosal resection (EMR) is essential. Training and experience in endoscopic ultrasound are highly desirable. The successful applicant's clinical practice will be based at SJHH, with participation in regional on-call rota.

Applicants should be certified (or eligible for certification) by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and must be licensed (or eligible for licensure) in the Province of Ontario. Additionally, applicants will have completed accredited training in gastroenterology and advanced endoscopy as above. All qualified applicants are encouraged to apply; however, Canadian citizens and permanent residents will be considered first for this position. To comply with the Government of Canada's reporting requirements, the University is obliged to gather information about applicants' status as either Permanent Residents of Canada or Canadian citizens. Applicants need not identify their country of origin or current citizenship; however, all applications must include one of the following statements:
