Position Description

The Department of Medicine of McGill University invites applications for a full-time Clinician-Teacher at the rank of Assistant Professor (Clinical). This is a Contract Academic Staff position and does not confer eligibility for tenure. The position is based at St. Mary's Hospital Centre in Montreal's Côte-des-Neiges borough.

McGill's Department of Medicine is a recognized leader in academic medicine. Our educational and research missions support excellent and innovative clinical programs across our teaching hospitals.

St. Mary's Hospital Centre is one of McGill's major teaching hospitals affiliated with the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences at Canada's internationally renowned McGill University, located in the vibrant and multicultural city of Montreal, in the province of Quebec. It is a community hospital with an important teaching mandate for trainees in multiple disciplines including internal medicine, general internal medicine and family medicine.

Job Duties

As a Clinician-Teacher, the successful candidate's major non-clinical focus will be on teaching the next generation of physicians. Teaching activity will include both didactic and clinical teaching.

The candidate is expected to provide the following Gastroenterology clinical services: Endoscopy Clinic, Consult Service, General Outpatient Clinic and cover evening and weekend on-call duties. The incumbent is expected to assist the academic program in clinical innovation in the Division of Gastroenterology.

McGill faculty members are expected to contribute to service activities within their units, the University, and the wider scholarly community. A demonstrated commitment to equity, diversity, and inclusion is also expected.

Qualifications and Education Requirements

- Candidates must hold an MD degree and must have completed specialty training in Gastroenterology;
- Candidates must be certified by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (or equivalent) and be eligible for licensure in Quebec and certification by the Collège des médecins du Québec;
- At least one additional year of clinical and /or research training is required;
- Strong interpersonal and leadership skills are essential;
- All candidates must be fluent in English with a working knowledge of French.
