



Cambridge Memorial Hospital (CMH) is looking for a **Gastroenterologist**.

CMH is undergoing a Capital Redevelopment Plan (CRP), with significant expansion of hospital services. As part of this CRP, CMH has an expanding Division Gastroenterology Division. This expansion includes developing and providing a new Endoscopic Ultrasound (EUS) program for the Waterloo Wellington region, with full support of our regional partner hospitals. CMH is seeking a gastroenterologist to help develop and deliver this EUS program, in conjunction with other EUS experts in the region (program will be sited at EUS). The candidate should have completed a formal 1 year EUS fellowship training program.

The Cambridge Memorial Hospital facilities include 2 endoscopy suites operating 5 days a week, and a third endoscopy suite projected to open in 2023 on completion of the CRP.

CMH currently has 4 gastroenterologists, an internist/hepatologist in the GI Division. While EUS is the primary focus of this position, the candidate should be comfortable with general GI practice in a community setting. Other areas of therapeutic endoscopy can be explored depending on training and expertise.

Applicants must be licensed with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario and have an independent practice license or eligible for same. Certification or eligibility for certification in Internal Medicine and Gastroenterology through the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons is also required.

On call requirements will be in GI only.
