



The Department of Medicine, Division of Gastroenterology at Michael Garron Hospital is seeking a LOCUM part time community Gastroenterologist who will care to a diverse general GI practice with a focus on inflammatory bowel disease. Additional IBD training is beneficial but not required. This is a turnkey practice with pre-established administrative support and office space in the medical office across the street from the hospital. Applicants must have successfully completed specialty qualifications from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and currently hold an independent license with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO).

In this position, you will provide outpatient and inpatient consultations and perform endoscopy. You will have access to endoscopy resources with partial anesthesia support. You will participate in 1 in 8 GI only on-call service with roughly 2 weekdays/month and 1 weekend/2 months. If interested there are opportunities for involvement in clinical teaching as well. Those with ERCP training are also encouraged to apply and additional resources would be available.
