

Red Deer - Alberta, Canada

The Red Deer Regional Hospital Centre is inviting applications to fill fee-for-service general Gastroenterology positions to provide care for the Central Zone of Alberta. The successful applicants will join a tight-knit division of four permanent gastroenterologists that is well supported with nurse-led Inflammatory Bowel Disease and Hepatitis C/Cirrhosis Care clinics. Those with advanced therapeutic endoscopy training including ERCP, EUS, and stent placement are encouraged to apply, but this training is not mandatory for all vacancies.

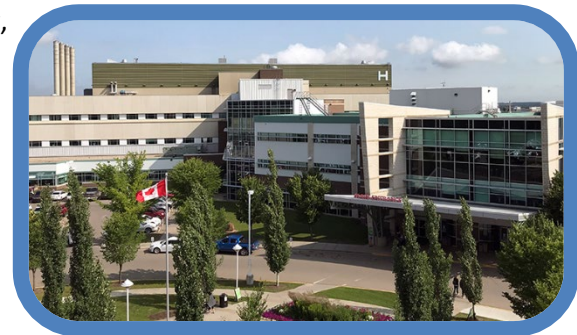
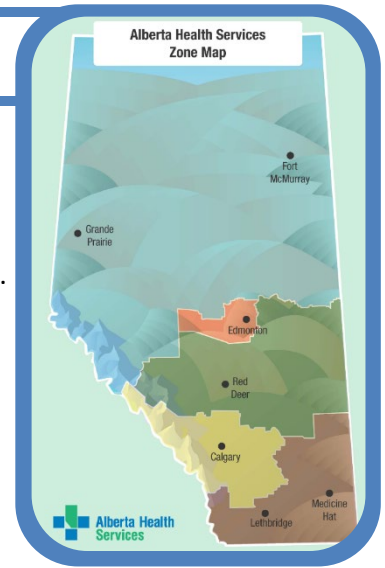
The successful candidates will enjoy two full days of endoscopy per week and the ability to join an established community-based office to see outpatients, allowing sharing of over-head costs and triaging of referrals. Successful applicants will participate in the Gastroenterology call schedule, with no requirement of Internal Medicine or Intensive Care Unit call coverage. The Gastroenterology on-call is purely consultative, and the division does not directly admit patients.

The Red Deer Regional Hospital Centre supports the over 450,000 residents of Central Alberta by providing 12,000 endoscopic procedures annually, including gastroscopy, colonoscopy, ERCP, stent placement, and video capsule endoscopy. The Endoscopy unit currently consists of 4 suites, but a major hospital expansion is underway, with planning to grow the endoscopy unit to 6 rooms with the potential for dedicated space and technology for advanced therapeutic endoscopy procedures. The gastroenterology division enjoys an excellent working relationship with the General Surgery group, who have advanced training in bariatric, colorectal surgery including TEMs and IPAA, and Ivor-Lewis esophagectomy.

Red Deer is a thriving family-friendly city of over 100,000 people that is in close proximity to the Rocky Mountains and many other outdoor attractions. We are ideally situated between Edmonton and Calgary, both less than an hour and a half drive away.

Eligible applicants must have one of the following qualifications:

- Candidates must hold a valid and relevant license with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Alberta.
- Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada Certification (RCPC)
- Applicant must also be able to provide proof of participation in relevant Continuing Medical Education (CME) programs
- Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support (ACLS)



Compensation is based on a fee for-service model with additional call stipends. Financial incentives such as paid travel arrangements and assistance with relocation is available.
