The successful candidate should be eligible for a full time clinical academic appointment at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor at the University of Toronto. Effective start date will be **September 1, 2018** or shortly thereafter as mutually agreed upon.

The successful applicant will lead the development of cutting edge academic programs and clinical initiatives as part of the Mount Sinai Hospital Inflammatory Bowel Disease Centre. The successful applicant should have a track record of clinical excellence or advanced training in the management of inflammatory bowel disease and advanced training in education or a track record of achievement in education or creative professional activity in the field of inflammatory bowel disease.

The Mount Sinai Hospital IBD Centre is based within Mount Sinai Hospital, part of Sinai Health System. It is one of the largest tertiary IBD centres in North America, consisting of a large interdisciplinary team.

The successful candidate must hold an MD degree and should have completed advanced inflammatory bowel disease specialist training. He/she should be eligible for certification in Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in Gastroenterology and have, or be eligible for, licensure in Ontario. Estimated remuneration will be in the range of \$250,000 to \$350,000, depending on fees for clinical service, and will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
