Description of the Offered Position:	<p>St. Mary's General Hospital and Grand River Hospital are currently seeking a Gastroenterologist with an ERCP fellowship to meet the growing needs of the Kitchener-Waterloo area. Each hospital has acute care ED services with patient volumes reaching approximately 55,000 visits/annum. St. Mary's General Hospital is a Regional Cardiac Care Centre and a Centre of Excellence for Respiratory and Thoracic Care. Grand River Hospital hosts several regional programs including the Grand River Regional Cancer Centre, Hepatobiliary Surgery, and stroke, renal, pediatric and mental health programs.</p>

	<p>The internal medicine program is represented by specialists in cardiology, critical care, endocrinology, gastroenterology, general internal medicine, geriatrics, hematology, infectious diseases, medical oncology, nephrology, respiratory. Additionally, there is diagnostic imaging support with access to interventional DI. The hospitals support a full-time pulmonary function lab, endoscopy unit, non-interventional cath lab, and nuclear medicine.</p> <p>In this position you would be joining our current group of 7 gastroenterologists and your duties will include inpatient consult service, on-call coverage, access to endoscopy time, as well as maintaining a community based practice. In this position you will also have the opportunity to teach medical students and residents through our affiliation with McMaster University Michael G. DeGroot School of Medicine.</p> <p>Candidates must possess or be able to obtain an unrestricted license to practice medicine in Ontario with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, and must hold or be eligible for fellowship in Gastroenterology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada. Candidates must have completed fellowship training in ERCP. A fellowship in advanced therapeutic endoscopy would be an asset.</p>
